Meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman Lamb.

Commissioner Turner makes a motion to accept the minutes from the August 16, 2023 meeting. Chairman Lamb seconds the motion. Unanimously passed.

St. Anthony Church, 126 School Street – Request for Waiver of Detail Requirements for Special Permits issued:

This matter came before the Commission in August and the Commission was concerned before a couple of the events fit the category of needing a police detail, but given the nature and the history they felt as long as they submitted a waiver the Commission would be okay with it.

Commissioner Turner makes a motion to approve the Request for Waiver of Details for the 4 dinners at St. Anthony Church. Chairman Lamb seconds the motion. Unanimously passed.

Segregansett Country Club, 85 Gulliver Street – Non-Profit Club Change of Officers/Directors:

Segregansett had submitted a change of manager and the list of officers didn't match what was on record. This change will allow the change of manager to be processed by the ABCC.

Commissioner Turner makes a motion to approve the Change of Officers/Directors. Chairman Lamb seconds the motion. Unanimously passed.

MPG Corporation d/b/a Rapid Refill, 231 Broadway – Change of Corporate Name or DBA, Change of Manager and Alteration of Premises:

Chairman Lamb states that the applicant did not notify the abutters and would like the matter placed on the October agenda.

Commissioner Turner makes a motion to table the matter to the October meeting. Chairman Lamb seconds the motion. Unanimously passed.

Tapped Beer Truck, 120 Jackson Street, Canton, MA – Application for a Special Permit for September 23, 2023 at 225 John Hancock Road, Taunton:

Andrew Gregory present on behalf of the applicant. This is a small event to be run by one of their operations managers that is Tips certified. Small event like last year from 12-3. They bring and remove the alcohol the day of the event. Detective Rutherford states that there weren't any issues last year.

Commissioner Turner makes a motion to approve the special permit for September 23rd at 225 John Hancock Road. Chairman Lamb seconds the motion. Unanimously passed.

Old Business/New Business:

Liberty & Union Alehouse - Ceasing operations as of the weekend and goal is for transfer paperwork to be submitted within 30-45 days.


The National, LLC – Will not be reopening and goal is to have transfer paperwork submitted within 30-45 days.
