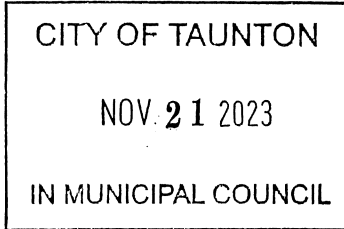
Mr. Postell confirmed that interviews were held on November 2. Based upon the list, the next person who would be up for recommendation to the full Council is Brady E. Nichols.
